




Part names



* MicroSD slot located internally under the battery cover


Notifications

Screen direction automatically adjusts to the orientation of the device



- The device uses a magnet to hold the touch pen in place. Only use the device with the included touch pen.
- Placing the device near televisions, radios, or other devices that receive an electrical signal could result in electrical noise.
- The screen uses an e-paper display. This means that the display may refresh slowly or have artifacts.
- Wipe away dirt with a clean, dry cloth.
- Solutions with benzene, thinners, or alcohol may affect the external appearance of the device or display and should not be used.

Inserting the batteries



All batteries should be of the same type (maker) and age. Mixing batteries could cause leaks or damage.

1. Prepare 4 AA alkaline or eneloop batteries.

Purchase batteries separately.

- 2. Press

 on the battery cover and slide it in the direction of the arrow to open.
- 3. Check the ends of the batteries and insert them properly.
- 4. Close the battery cover.

Initial settings



After inserting the battery, the language setting screen will be shown following the opening screen.

Select the language by tapping あ for Japanese, A for English and proceed to the next screen.

Note: You can perform this setting only when batteries are replaced.





Adjust the positioning.

Tap the 3 + icons in order of appearance.

The device will proceed to the next screen once the position is adjusted.






Select the battery type.

Tap either "alkaline" or "eneloop" to select the battery type and proceed to the next screen.

This setting ensures the correct battery life is displayed.

Note: You can perform this setting only when batteries are replaced.






Set the date and time.

Tap the year (last two digits), month, day, hour, and minute to set the values. Change the values by tapping the correct numbers.

When finished, tap or.
The initial settings are now complete.

Performing the main settings

Refer to "Initial settings" for setting the date and time. • Power management: Displays the type of battery and

remaining battery life. • Auto-sleep: Sets the time period for auto-sleep. The sleep icon will be shown in the bottom right when active.

Sets the screen to be shown during sleep mode. Tappng the screen wakes the device from sleep mode.

Sets the first day of the week (Sunday or Monday).

Refer to "Initial settings" to calibrate the screen.

Password entry.

- If no password is set, you can create a new one.
- If a password is set, it deletes the password.
- Export: Exports memo data to the microSD card.
- Import: Imports memo data from the microSD card. For details, refer to the following website.

Formats the memory on the device. This deletes all saved data.


Tap a day to display the corresponding memos with an alarm set. Tap and hold to create a new memo with an alarm set.
